Money Vocabulary

Count – to add the total amount of

Penny – one one-hundredth of a dollar. There are 100 pennies in a dollar.

Nickel – one twentieth of a dollar. There are 20 nickels in a dollar.

Dime – one tenth of a dollar. There are 10 dimes in a dollar.

Dollar – the basic money unity, made up of 100 pennies.

Quarter -- one fourth of a dollar. There are 4 quarters in a dollar.

Add – to count the total number of something

Coin -- round metal units of money that equal parts of a dollar

Money – coins and bills that we use to buy and sell things

Cash – real dollars and coins

Change – money that you get back when you pay more than something costs

Wallet – a small flat case you carry your money in

Save – to keep your money without spending it

Spend – to use your money to buy things

Bank – a safe place for people to keep their money

Check – a piece of paper you can use instead of money to pay for something; the check takes money out of your bank account
